## **Membership report for 2017 AGM**

The chart (over) of membership stats for the last 9 years or so shows a slow drift downwards in Household membership from a high of 441 in 2007/8 to 340 now, which a drop of 111 households over 9 years. I notice as people either leave or die that others join us but as we can see at a slower rate than those departing. So we are experiencing a slow attrition.

I think perhaps the reason for this is three-fold; a decreasing interest in things considered "religious", the availability of so much information on the internet or the lack of any sort of advertising to people who might not be aware of us and what we do.

We also have a lot of confusion of who is a member when we refer to Households and Members. In my view, irrespective of how many people live at an address or show joint interest, this should be considered one member. Whether the newsletter is shared around is irrelevant IMHO. Perhaps the new Steering Committee might wrestle with this one too.
