

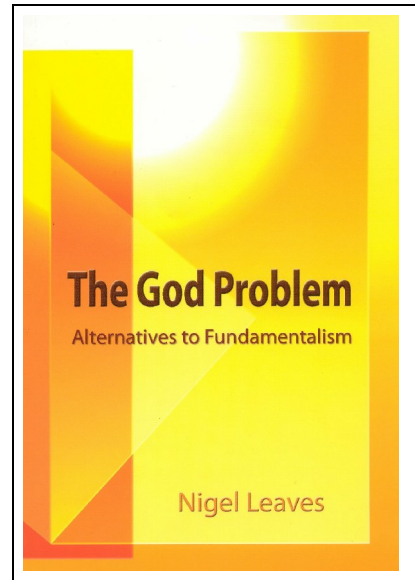
Manifesto Of Reason
